To **Download an audiobook**, click "add to digital cart" (shown with the **pink arrow** below). You will be prompted to enter your library card number. Choose how long you wish to borrow the title for (7, 14, or 21 days). Once you have checked the audiobook out, a Download button will appear and enable you to download the audiobook to your computer. You want to choose the option to OPEN with Overdrive Media Console, not save the file. If a title is unavailable, there will be an option to "join the waiting list." You will be notified via email when the audiobook is available for checkout.

What is the difference between a WMA file and an MP3 file?

There are many differences between these 2 file types. The most important differences are that the Windows Media Audio (WMA) files cannot be downloaded to a Mac, or an iOS mobile device. WMA files can however be transferred to an iPod if you are using a PC and use the OverDrive Media Console to transfer the audiobook. MP3 files can be downloaded to either a Mac or a PC and can be transferred to any device that supports MP3 files. MP3 files are also larger in size than WMA files.

How can I tell what devices an audiobook is compatible with?

Under each title, there is an image indicating which devices the title is compatible with. Some titles are available in both mp3 and wma format, so be sure you checkout and download the correct one.

I checked out an audiobook, but it will not download to my Mac.

Check the file type of the audiobook you checked out. Verify that you audiobook is in mp3 file format. WMA files are not compatible with Macs, and you will not be able to download them to your Mac.

Can I return an audiobook early?

No, it is not possible to return an audiobook early. If you are finishing your audiobooks quickly, you may want to consider checking your titles out for a shorter lending period.

When my checkout time is over, does the audiobook disappear from my mp3 player?

No. You will need to remove the audiobook from your device by connecting it to your computer and opening either iTunes or Windows Media Player (depending on your device). Then deleting the audiobook files from your device through either of these programs.

Can I renew an audiobook?

No, you cannot renew an audiobook in OverDrive. However, you are able to check the audiobook out again if a copy is available. You will need to find the title in the OverDrive Catalog, check it out and download it again so that the license file is updated.

I got an email that an audiobook I put a hold on is ready for checkout, but it is not in My Digital Cart in OverDrive.

Log into your Digital Account at overdrive.libraryweb.org. View your Waiting List; the audiobook you had on hold will be here and you will need to click on the link to add the title to your Digital Cart. You can then check out and download the title.

I have the Overdrive Media Console installed on my computer, but the eBook I checked out will not open in it.

eBooks will not open in the Overdrive Media Console (the mobile app is the exception for mobile devices) on your computer. You will need to download and install Adobe Digital Editions for the eBook. Please see the eBook brochure for more information.

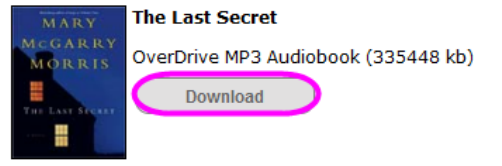
OverDrive Media Console

OverDrive Media Console is free software that is used to manage and listen to downloaded library audiobooks, and transfer these audiobooks to supported mp3 players. It can be downloaded at overdrive.libraryweb.org under "Software Downloads" at the bottom of the left-hand column.

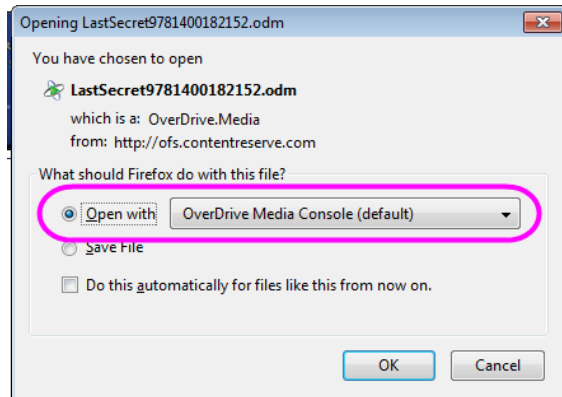
If you do not already have it installed, you will need to download Windows Media Player 9 (or newer). You can get it here: <http://goo.gl/kq40H>

If you are going to be transferring audiobooks to an Apple Device you will need to have iTunes 9.1 (or newer) installed on your computer as well, which you can download here: <http://goo.gl/fMTIX>

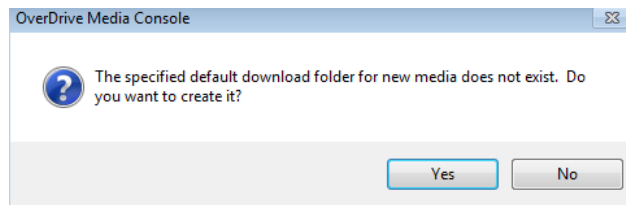
Once you have checked out an audiobook, you will have a download button available to you :



When you click on the download button, a pop-up window should appear. You want to Open the file with Overdrive Media Console (see below):



The first time you download a book, the folder location may need to be created—you can say yes to this prompt (to the right):

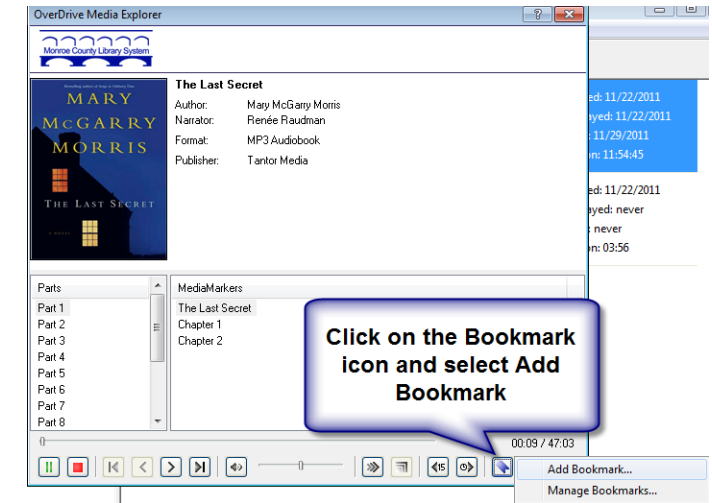
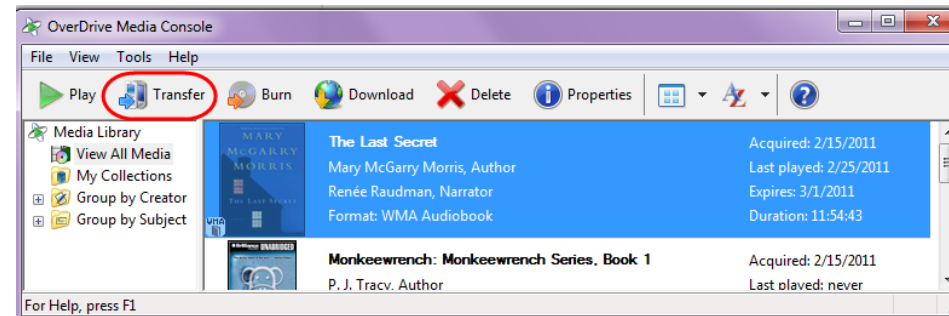


Using OverDrive Media Console on the Computer:

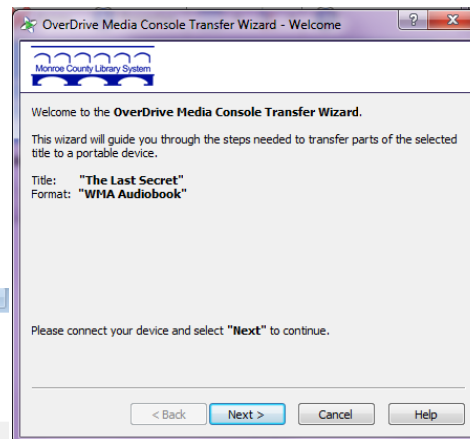
When you have checked out and downloaded your audiobook from OverDrive, the audiobook will open in the Media Console. If you are going to listen to your audiobook on your computer, you can add digital bookmarks so that you can easily pick up where you left off. (see image to the right)

Transferring an audiobook to a mp3 player:

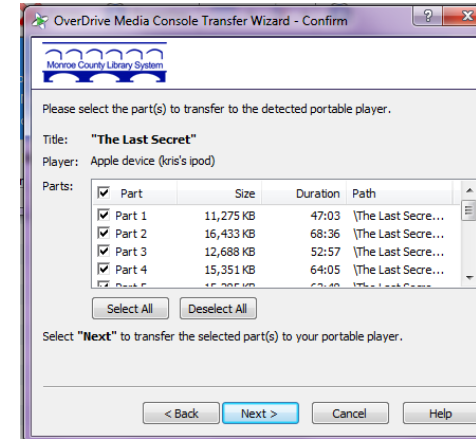
Connect your device to your computer and open Overdrive Media Console. Select the title you wish to transfer to your device and using your mouse, click on the Transfer button that is in the top left corner of the Media Console Window (circled below in red).



The transfer wizard will open, click next to continue.



Select all the parts that you wish to transfer to your device, then click Next



Once the audiobook is transferred, you will be able to disconnect your device as you normally would.
