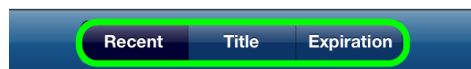
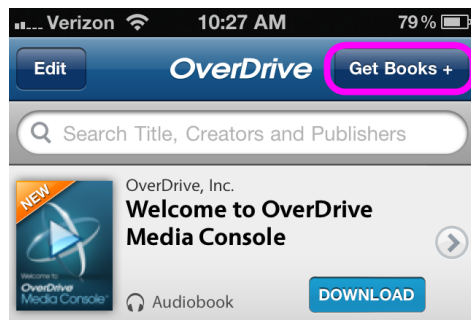


After acknowledging the Adobe screen, you will be viewing your Bookshelf. There is already an audiobook available to download which is an introduction to Overdrive.

You can sort the titles on your bookshelf by any of the options (**circled in green below**) at the bottom of your screen.



Tap on the Get Books + button (**circled in pink above**) in order to start your search for books.

Downloadable FAQs

What is the difference between a WMA file and an MP3 file?

There are many differences between these 2 file types. The most important differences are that the Windows Media Audio (WMA) files cannot be downloaded to a Mac, or an iOS mobile device. WMA files can however be transferred to an iPod *if* you are using a PC and use the OverDrive Media Console to transfer the audiobook (see our brochure on Overdrive Audiobooks for more information). MP3 files can be downloaded to either a Mac or a PC and can be transferred to any device that supports MP3 files. MP3 files are also larger in size than WMA files.

Can I return an audiobook early?

No, it is not possible to return an audiobook early. If you are finishing your audiobooks quickly, you may want to consider checking your titles out for a shorter lending period.

When my checkout time is over, does the eBook or Audiobook disappear from my device?

No. You will need to delete the book from your account. See inside on how to do this.

Can I renew an audiobook or eBook?

No, you cannot renew in OverDrive. However, you are able to check the book out again if a copy is available. You will need to find the title in the OverDrive Catalog, check it out and download it again so that the license file is updated.

I got an email that a book I put a hold on is ready for checkout, but it is not in My Digital Cart in OverDrive.

Log into your Digital Account at overdrive.libraryweb.org. View your Waiting List; the book you had on hold will be here and you will need to click on the link to add the title to your Digital Cart. You can then check out and download the title.

Can I download Kindle Books to my device with the Kindle App?

Yes, You can download Kindle Books to a device that has the free Amazon Kindle app installed. See our brochure on eBooks for the Kindle.

Overview

Overdrive Media Console App enables you to download mp3 audiobooks and epub eBooks from the Monroe County Library System.

The OverDrive Media Console App is a free app that can be downloaded from your respective App Store/Market. It is available for devices running at least: iOS 4.0, Android 1.5, Blackberry 4.7, or Windows Phone 7.

The screenshots throughout this brochure are from the iPhone, but the app looks and functions very much the same across devices.

When you launch Overdrive Media Console for the first time, you may be prompted to authorize the App with an Adobe ID. If you already have an Adobe ID, you can sign in. If you do not, you will need to register at Adobe with the link provided. Or you can go to <http://goo.gl/mCscR> to create an Adobe ID. **Note:** You need only Authorize the Media Console with an Adobe ID if you want to read an eBook. You need not do this if you only want to listen to audiobooks.

You can always do this step at a later time as well if you choose to do so.



Get Books

After tapping on the **Get Books +** button, tap **Add a Library (image 1 below)**. Enter your zip code and tap search. Select your local public library from the list, then select Monroe County Library System (**image 2 below**).

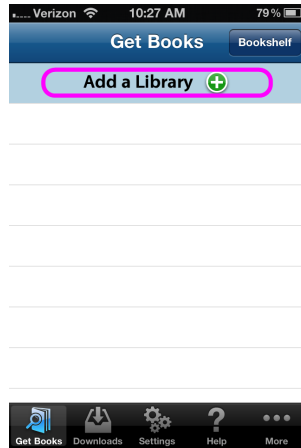

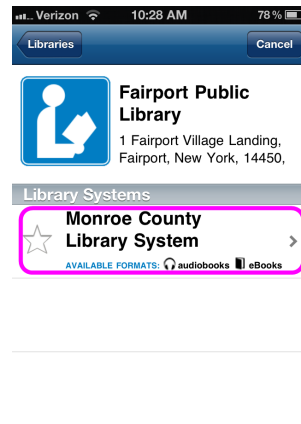
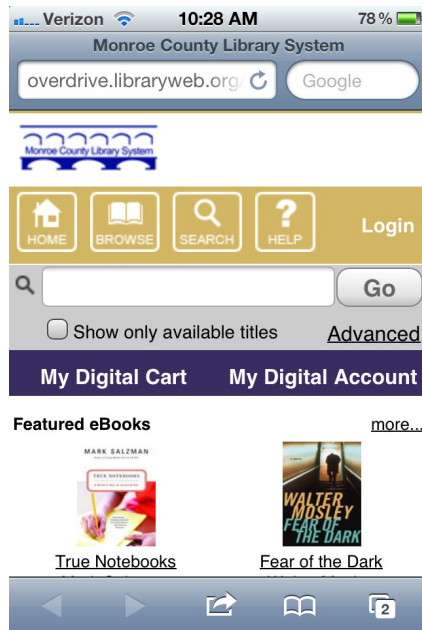

Searching the Catalog



You can search the Monroe County Library's collection of eBooks and eAudiobooks directly from your mobile device. Enter an author or title and tap Go. If you wish to only see items that are available, be sure to Check the box *Show only available titles*.

An advanced search is also available, which may be helpful if you would like to limit your results to a particular format (epub or mp3) or if you would like to browse a specific genre.

Checking Out: Add titles that you would like to download to your digital cart and complete your checkout using your library card number. Once you have completed your checkout, tap the Download button that is available below the title.

Note that you must be connected to a Wi-Fi Network in order to download audiobooks.

To begin Reading a library eBook, tap on the thumbnail cover of the title. To navigate forward through the book, tap on the right side of your devices' screen. To flip to a previous page, tap on the left side of the devices' screen.

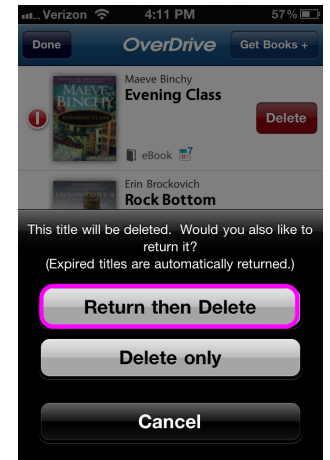
On the iOS devices, to activate the eBook controls tap in the middle of a page. This will make available controls to adjust the font size, brightness, table of contents, and manage your bookmarks. For other devices, you will need to first press the menu key to access your controls.

To begin listening to a library audiobook, tap on the thumbnail cover of the title. The book should immediately begin playing. Your controls will be available at the top and bottom of your screen, where you can fast forward, rewind, pause, and add bookmarks.

Returning Books

Returning eBooks:

It is possible to return eBooks early. Open the Overdrive App, you will want to be viewing your Bookshelf. On Apple Devices, Tap the "Edit" button at the top left corner of your screen. Then tap the red circle next to the title you want to return and then tap "Delete". You will then have the option to "Return then Delete" that title. If your book has already expired, you will only have the option to delete the eBook. If you are using an Android device, you can delete a title by first opening the eBook and then by pressing the "Menu Key" and tapping "Delete".



Deleting Audiobooks:

You can remove titles from your Library on Apple devices by tapping the "Edit" button at the top left corner of your screen while in the Library View. Tap the red circle next to the title you want to delete and then tap "Delete". If you are using an Android device, you can delete a title by first opening the audiobook and then by pressing the "Menu Key" and tapping "Delete". Deleting the audiobook removes it from your device, it does not remove it from your OverDrive Account (***it is not possible to return audiobooks early***).
